

State of Illinois Health Requirements for the Alton School District

Students starting at the beginning of the school year will **NOT** be able to attend school after October 1st until **ALL** required information is received. Transfers/out of district students will have 30 school days to turn in their paperwork once they start school. **All students, upon first entry into an Illinois school beyond kindergarten are required to have an eye exam.** All physicals must be dated within one year of starting school.

Preschool Students:

- Physical Exam on required Illinois form (Parents please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign/date)
- Complete immunization record: (4) DTap, (3) Polio, (4)Hib, (3)Hep B, (1)MMR, (1)Varicella, (4) Pneumococcal
- Birth Certificate

Kindergarten Students:

- Physical Exam on required Illinois form (Parents please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign/date)
- Complete immunization record: (4)DTap, (4) Polio, (2)MMR, (2)Varicella
- Dental exam on required Illinois form due May 15th (dated within 18 months of deadline)
- Eye exam on Illinois form (dated within one year of 1st day of school)
- Birth Certificate

Second Grade Students:

- Dental exam on required Illinois form due May 15th (dated within 18 months of deadline)

Sixth Grade Students:

- Physical Exam on required Illinois form (Sports physical is NOT acceptable; Parents please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign/date)
- Complete immunization record including (1)Tdap, (1) Meningitis and (3) Hep B
- Dental exam on required Illinois form due May 15th (dated within 18 months of deadline)

Ninth Grade Students:

- Physical Exam on required Illinois form (Sports Physical is NOT acceptable; Parents please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign/date)
- Dental exam on required Illinois form due May 15th (dated within 18 months of deadline)

Twelfth Grade Students:

- Proof of receiving (2) Meningitis shots: First dose received on or after the 11th Birthday and second dose received at least 8 weeks after the first. Only one dose is required if the first dose was received at 16 years of age or older.
